Monday – Friday: 8 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. or 12:30 p.m. – 4 p.m.

Minimum Age to Volunteer – 18 (with the following exception):

- **Orange County Toy Collaborative** – Volunteers between the ages of 13 – 17 may volunteer if accompanied by a parent/guardian who is 21 years of age or older.
