Description of actual or threatened illegal hazardous waste discharge: Ambient air monitoring and sample collection conducted by the South Coast AQMD on November 7, 2023, has detected asbestos from debris near the Marine Corps Air Station Tustin Hangars located in the City of Tustin in the area surrounding 72-7 Tustin Ranch Road. Ambient air monitoring and sample collection was conducted to assess the health risk. The preliminary debris analysis results received on November 8, 2023, confirmed >1% of asbestos in the debris likely to affect public health or safety near the Marine Corps Air Station Tustin Hangars.
